Places

Brickyard | track's nickname from when it was fully paved inbricks

Gasoline Alley | name of the garage area

Victory Lane | where the winning team will celebrate

DAY BY DAY

PRACTICES | Tuesday, May 16 - Monday, May 20

30 hours for safety, highest speeds on the calendar. Rookie orientation for first timers and a refresher for part time drivers

FAST FRIDAY | Friday, May 17th

only practice with a 'power boost' of 90bhp to simulate qualifying runs

QUALIFYING | Saturday, May 18 - Sunday, May 19

DAY 1 | full field participates, first attempts randomly ordered, 2 warm up laps, 4 timed laps, aggregate of the 4 is the quali time. Second attempts into two lanes: lane 1 gets priority but forfeits previous time, lane two keeps previous time. Positions 13-30 set.

DAY 2 | Bump Day | 33 spots, 34 entries

TOP 12 | fastest from day 1, single attempts from slowest to fastest. Positions 7-12 set.

LAST CHANCE | cars outside day 1 top 30, guaranteed one attempt, others available time permitting (1 hr session), only three spots available. Positions 31-33 set.

FIRESTONE FAST SIX | attempts ordered slowest to fastest from the top 12, single attempts. Positions 6-1, including Pole, set.

CARB DAY | Friday, May 24th

ft a practice session, pit stop challenge and a concert for those who are trackside

RACE DAY | Sunday, May 26th

Rolling start | three wide race start

Pit Stops | 6+ stops, preferably during a safety period, tyre changes and/or refuelling

Points | all drivers in the field receive championship points, top 12 qualifiers get 'bonus' points.

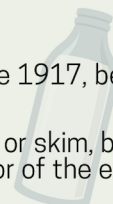
TRADITIONS

Back Home Again in Indiana | song performed at the race since 1917, before the race since 1946.

Victory Milk | the race winner will get their choice of whole, 2% or skim, began to promote the American dairy industry who once were a sponsor of the event. Will be kept in a locked briefcase, handcuffed to its minder.

Kiss the Bricks | used to be fully paved with bricks, now only the start/finish line, winning team will kiss the bricks, started in 1996 by Dale Jarrett.

Borg-Warner Trophy | sculpted faces of the winners adorn it. Made of sterling silver. Winners get mini versions to take home.
